



[Cerro Prieto](#) is the oldest and largest Mexican geothermal field in operation and its first power units were commissioned in 1973.

The Cerro Prieto geothermal field is located in the alluvial plain of the Mexican Valley, approximately 30 km south of the border between Mexico and the United States.

Study, Field Evaluation of Unit II, Contract Design of Units II and III.
